

REPORT
on the work of the RSPP Committee on Industrial Policy and Technical Regulation for 2022

I. Industrial policy and import substitution

As part of **the work to support domestic industrial enterprises**:

- Experts of the Committee took part in the preparation of 7 draft amendments to the Federal Law "On Industrial Policy in the Russian Federation", including issues of stimulating the production of domestic products.
 - The collection and analysis of systemic enterprises and their consideration in the decision-making of federal executive bodies has been organized.
 - For example, in order to stimulate demand for Russian goods, amendments were made to the RF PP 2013 and 2014;
 - in order to simplify the procedures for confirming the Russian origin of goods, amendments have been made to PP RF 719, etc.
 - More than **40** draft legal acts on measures of state support for industry, including the tools of **the NWPC**,, public procurement, industrial mortgage, etc., were analyzed and reviewed.
 - The collection and submission of information to the interested federal executive bodies on ensuring sustainable logistics for passenger and freight traffic has been organized.
 - The Committee's proposals were taken into account in the preparation of the "Strategy for the Development of the Metallurgical Industry of the Russian Federation for the Period up to 2030", the "Consolidated Strategy for the Development of the Manufacturing Industry of the Russian Federation until 2024 and for the Period up to 2035", the "Transport Strategy of the Russian Federation until 2030 with a Forecast for the Period up to 2035" and other conceptual documents.\
 - Using the Resources of the Committee, enterprises are informed about the federal and regional support measures being taken.
- In terms of assisting enterprises in **solving import substitution issues**:
- nomenclature in the database of import substitution of the GISP, as well as chemical products of import-substituting building materials;
 - the priority needs of low-tonnage chemistry in the road industry have been formed;
 - a scientific and practical conference "**Import substitution of materials, equipment and technologies in the field of general civil and transport construction**" was held, the solutions of which are implemented by federal executive bodies and organizations;
 - with the support of the Committee, intersectoral interaction between sectoral and regional public associations and industrial enterprises has been organized.

In order to form the key parameters of the **new mode of operation of industrial clusters**:

- taking into account the proposals, regulatory acts have been adopted in terms of ensuring a preferential regime for the implementation of activities in industrial parks and industrial technoparks, their simplified administration, reimbursement of costs for the creation, modernization of infrastructure facilities, etc.
- interaction with interested technoparks has been organized.

II. Implementation of the "Road Map" between the Russian Union of Industrialists and Entrepreneurs and the Ministry of Construction of Russia

On 29.06.2022 , at the Congress of the Russian Union of Industrialists and Entrepreneurs, the second "Roadmap for cooperation between the RSPP and the Ministry of Construction of Russia in the field of technical regulation and improvement of the regulatory framework in construction for 2022-2023" was signed.

With the participation of the Committee's experts, draft Action Plan ("Road Map") was developed to expand the scope of steel in construction using steel structures for 2022-2026. and the Action Plan ("Road Map") to improve technical regulation in the field of construction and fire safety of capital construction projects using steel structures for 2022-2026.

16 projects of buildings on a metal frame were adopted by the Ministry of Construction of Russia as standard.

The experts of the Committee worked in the following working groups:

1. on technical standardization in the construction industry under the Government Commission for Regional Development in the Russian Federation;
2. WG of the Ministry of Construction of Russia and the Ministry of Industry and Trade of Russia on the development of technical regulations of the EAEU "On the safety of building materials and products" (the 1st edition of the draft TR of the EAEU was prepared);
3. technical standardization in the construction sector;
4. to increase the use of metal in construction.

Taking into account the proposals of the Committee's experts , the Strategy for the Development of the Construction Industry and housing and communal services of the Russian Federation until 2030 was adopted with a forecast for the period up to 2035.

The finalization of the draft Concept for Improving the System of Technical Regulation and Regulation in the Construction Industry continues on the proposals of the RSPP Committee.

III. Technical regulation, standardization, conformity assessment and metrology

In connection with the introduction of sanctions on 28.03.2022. a meeting was held with the participation of the leadership of the Ministry of Industry and Trade, the Ministry of Economic Development, Rosstandart and Rosaccreditation, during which a set of measures was identified to overcome the sanctions regime in the field of technical regulation, standardization, conformity assessment and ensuring the unity of measurements.

Within the framework of the EASC meeting on 13.07.2022, **a Cooperation Agreement was signed between the RSPP Committee and the Interstate Council for Standardization, Metrology and Certification.**

During the year, conclusions were sent twice to the draft "Roadmap for the development of the technical regulation system in the Russian Federation for the period up to 2025" (as of December 2022, the project is being finalized).

With the participation of the Committee's experts:

- drafts of amendments to the **Federal Law "On Technical Regulation"** and the **Federal Law "On Ensuring the Uniformity of Measurements"** were prepared;
- work continued on updating **PP RF No. 2425** (2 surveys were conducted on the necessary adjustment of standards for the purposes of certification and declaration of conformity of products.
- **conclusions were prepared on 9 projects of the TR CU and TR EAEU** and amendments to them.

Work continued on the restoration of state control and supervision over the requirements of **13** technical regulations and products included in the RF PP 2425. Appeals of the RSPP dated 12.08.2022 and 21.10.2022 were sent to Deputy Prime Ministers of the Russian Federation **Manturov D.V. and Grigorenko D.Yu.**

The restoration of state control **was supported on 13.10.2022 by the Bureau of the Board of the Russian Union of Industrialists and Entrepreneurs** and on 13.12.2022. at a joint meeting with the Committee on Control and Supervisory Activities and the Committee of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Russian Federation on Technical Regulation of Standardization and Product Quality.

A survey of the following companies was conducted:

- on the use of foreign standards in various industries for the purpose of prompt development on their basis of GOST and GOST R (proposals were given by more than **40 companies**, they were sent to Rosstandart);
- to overcome the consequences of sanctions in the field of metrology (proposals were given by more than **60 companies**, they were sent to the Ministry of Industry and Trade of Russia and Rosstandart);"
- on the problems of implementing the requirements of the technical regulations of the EAEU (proposals from **25 companies**

were sent to the EEC).

Discussions were held and conclusions were given on more than **60 draft standards** and other documents of various TCs on standardization.

ITC 536 "Methodology of Interstate Standardization" supported the proposal of the RSPP Committee regarding the improvement of the voting mechanism for draft interstate standards in the EASC member states, which will speed up their adoption.

IV. International cooperation

In connection with the introduction of new sanctions against Russia by unfriendly countries in 2022:

- A number of standardization bodies have ceased cooperation with Russia, including European standards organizations (CEN/CENELEC), US standards bodies (ASTM, API);
- Certificates of conformity issued earlier by foreign certification bodies (TUV, UKAS, Veritas and others) were revoked or revoked.
- Many of the Committee's projects in the European direction were frozen, including the work of the "Council for Standardization and Technical Regulation for the Digitalization of the Economy with the Eastern Committee of the German Economy", which held 2 meetings in 2022 - in January and March.

However, cooperation continued with **international standardization organizations**.

The Committee participated in **the ISO General Assemblies, the IEC, and the B20 forums**.

The Economic Commission for Europe has extended for 2 years the mandate for Russia (RSPP Committee) to conduct **the "Initiative on the Safety of Trunk Pipelines" (UNECE WG 6)**.

A **Cooperation Agreement was signed with the IGU**, which allows Russian industry to participate more actively in interstate standardization and opens up new opportunities for the development of international cooperation.

The cooperation of the RSPP Committee with **the EAEU Business Council** continued. Taking into account the work carried out by the RSPP Committee, proposals were prepared for the creation of a **"Committee on Technical Regulation"** in its composition. This work can be one of the priority activities of the RSPP Committee and the EAEU Business Council in 2023.

In connection with the development of product supplies to Russia and the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, in November 2022, during the visit of the Russian business mission to this country, a representative of the Committee made a number of reports on the system of technical regulation in Russia and the EAEU.
